Ratio Analysis 9/17/2025



Gross Profit Margin

Gross Profit Margin =

(Revenue - Cost of goods sold) / Revenue

Derived from income statement

Classified as one of the profitability ratios

Reveals fundamental business quality

Indicates scalability potential

Signals pricing power

Harder to manipulate metric

Operating Margin

Operating Margin =

Operating income / Revenue

Operating Income = Revenue – Cost of goods sold – Operating Expenses

- Derived from income statement
- Measures how efficient the company manages its operations
- Excludes any impact of financing decisions and taxes
- Better indicator of sustainable earnings than net margin and is less affected by non-operational items

Current Ratio

Current Ratio =

Current Assets / Current Liabilities

- Derived from balance sheet statement
- Measures a company's ability to pay short-term obligations
- . Indicates short-term financial health
- Shows working capital efficiency

Debt to Equity Ratio

Debt to Equity =

Total liability / Shareholders' equity

- Derived from balance sheet statement
- · Reveals financial risk profile
- Affects the quality of return on equity
- Higher leverage means higher borrowing costs which affects company's ability to generate attractive returns over time

Free Cash Flow Yield

FCF yield =

Total liability / Shareholders' equity

- · Derived from cash flow statement
- Shows real value generation
- Reveals true return potential
- Indicates capital allocation flexibility
- Forward looking
- Filters out accounting noise
