SCG Guidelines

- Be sure your <u>SSGs are current</u> & <u>your</u> <u>judgements complete</u>
- SCG works best with same/similar industries
- Judgements must be <u>reasonable & valid</u>
- Be careful if SSGs are completed by several different people in a Club


SCG: Comparison Strategies


- Select best Company: highlight positive numbers
- Filter: Add companies in same industry/sector without judgement
- **Contrarian**: compare companies in same industry/highlight negatives to remove companies


